BENEFITS

- You will be paid \$150.
- You will gain practical experience serving your community and state while learning about the democratic process.
- Experience as a student election judge looks great on a resume or college application.

QUALIFICATIONS

- 16 years old and either a junior or senior in good standing in a public or private school, or home schooled.
- Ability to work a 14-hour day. Mentally and physically able to perform the assigned tasks.
- Written permission from your parent or legal guardian and your principal.
- US Citizen by Election Day.
- Not related to a candidate on the ballot.
- Free of convictions for fraud or election offenses.

STUDENT JUDGES

Qualified high school juniors and seniors who are at least 16 years old may serve as election judges. Student judges serve alongside other adult election judges at the polling places.

WHAT DOES AN ELECTION JUDGE DO?

Election judges are assigned by the Clerk and Recorder to confirm voters' eligibility, provide assistance with forms, activate voting machines, and generally assist voters. Each polling place has a supply judge and several support judges. Student judges will assist with the following tasks:

- Arrive at the polling place by 6:00 a.m. on Election Day.
- Greet, check in and process voters.
- Distribute ballots and assist voters with voting machines.
- Answer voters' questions and help those who need assistance.
- Perform all duties assigned by the Clerk and Recorder.
- Stay at the polling place and assist with closing procedures until completed.
