A MESSAGE FROM THE COUNTY CLERK

Dear Election Judge:

I want to thank all of you for the comments you have supplied me with over the past few elections. With this in mind, I have redesigned the pre-printed applications. They will no longer be in the application books; instead they will be in a blue pre-printed application 3-ring binder.

In the front of your binder you will find alphabetical tabs which can be inserted and used to more easily locate the voter's application. The application has been changed slightly. Below is an example of the new pre-printed application. Please take note of the arrows to identify the various parts that will need to be completed on Election Day.

Station #1 – Voter Verification



Two Judges, one from each political party must be at Station #1 at all times.

This is a very important station because you're determining if a voter is qualified to vote by verifying their name and address and comparing their current signature with their facsimile signature that they provided when they registered to vote. Be sure to give the voter a receipt with their ballot style and tell them to make sure they receive the correct ballot.



Supplies to be placed at Station #1:

- Laminated Station #1 Quick Reference Guide
- AutoMARK "Optical Scan Voting" table sign
- "Form Line Here" laminated table sign (to be taped to the front of the table)
- Pre-printed application books
- Black pens
- Election Judge Manual
- Election Day Binder
